Chapter 19 Labour Labour Laws Ustr - 19-4 3. Nothing in this Chapter shall be construed to empower a Party's authorities to undertake labour law enforcement activities in the territory of another Party. Article 19.6: Forced or Compulsory Labour. Each Party recognises the goal of eliminating all forms of forced or compulsory labour, including forced or compulsory child labour.activities among the fundamental labour rights and acceptable conditions of work enumerated in Article (Labour Rights) 19.3.1 Article 19and .3.2 (Labour Rights), provided the that exercise of that discretion, and those decisions, are not inconsistent with its obligations under this Chapter.It also includes commitments, again required for all TPP Parties, to have laws governing minimum wages, hours of work, and occupational safety and health. The Labor chapter bars TPP Parties from waiving or derogating from laws implementing fundamental labor rights in a manner affecting trade or investment.Regulates labor law in the United States. Called the Wagner Act after its author. Created the National Labor Relations Board to enforce labor laws. Prohibits employers from penalizing workers who engage in union activity. Prohibits unions from penalizing workers who refuse to engage in union activity.
